## Vettography 101

Want to take some great pics of your Vette? Here are a few tips that will help get some knock out shots of your ride



### Get Low

Taking a picture of your Vette is a lot like taking a picture of children: Get down on their level. Kneel or squat down to get the low and wide angle.

If your camera allows, shoot on Aperture priority (AV) and select an aperture of at least 8.0. This will provide good depth of field and help ensure the entire subject is in focus.

### Dare to be different

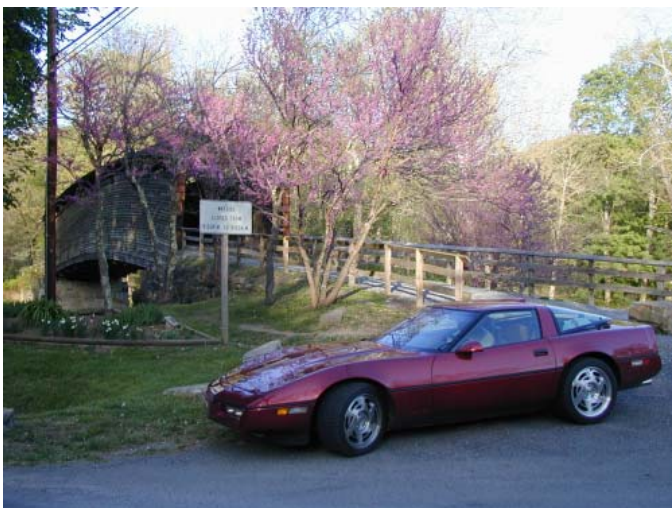
Try something different like night shooting. This photo was taken on film several years ago, but digital photography has made experimentation cheap. Get a decent tripod or find something to support the camera and hold it steady. Use the cameras built in timer to help get a shake free shot.



### Show the big picture

The Vette does not always have to be the subject. Use it as a prop to show off the bigger picture.

Try to avoid placing the car in the center of the frame, either horizontally or vertically.

## MONTHLY MEETING MINUTES January 19, 2010

### CALL TO ORDER

President Dave Hurt called the meeting to order at 6:55 p.m. Dave welcomed 38 members, 2 spouses and guest, Bob Shofner, to the first meeting of 2010.

### APPROVAL OF MINUTES

November meeting minutes were included in the January newsletter. A motion was made and seconded to accept the November minutes as submitted.

### TREASURER'S REPORT

A motion was made and seconded to accept the Treasurer's report as read.

### ANNOUNCEMENTS

1. Dave thanked the outgoing Officers and Board members for their service to TSCC during the past year.
2. Dave informed the members that Sherry Taber was recently hospitalized. A card will be sent to Sherry on behalf of TSCC. Dave also informed members that information concerning members' hospitalizations, etc. should be sent to Joanne Will who will send a card on behalf of TSCC.
3. The 2010 Board of Directors listed in the January newsletter was incomplete. Board members were announced to the membership; Dan Jacquess, Chairman; Larry Farmer, Doug Stevens, Tim Seib, Mark Smith. Jeff Burden is the Alternate.
4. Dave passed along the appreciation of Pizza Chef management to TSCC for continuing to hold our monthly meetings at the restaurant.

### NEW BUSINESS

1. TSCC Cruise In: Dave informed the members that Oct. 2 or Oct. 9 were proposed for a club cruise-in at Kenny Kent Chevrolet. Members voted to accept Oct 9 as the date for the cruise-in. Bob Holder later expressed concern the Oct. 9 date would conflict with the Westside Nut Club's fall Festival parade, as some members participate in the parade. Changing the date to Oct. 2 would conflict with the Brown County Fun Day event. It was then learned the Brown County Fun Day is scheduled for Sunday, Oct. 3. Members then voted to hold the TSCC Cruise-In on Saturday October 2, 2010 at Kenny Kent Chevrolet. Suggested hours for the cruise-in are 3pm to 8pm. Mike reported that Kenny Kent has a 'music van' available for the cruise-in. Kenny Kent will also place an ad in 'Mike Lang's Cruise-In' book advertising the event. Doug Stevens and Mike Hudson will co-chair the event. Dan Jacquess and Mark Smith will assist.

2. TSCC Picnic: Dave proposed the summer picnic be held at Wesselman Woods on Sunday, June 6 or Sunday, July 18. Members voted to hold the picnic on Sunday, June 6 at Wesselman. Dave will make arrangements to secure the pavilions. A committee will be established in the near future to coordinate the event and activities.
3. Cave-In-Rock Outing: Dave informed the members of a proposed road trip to Cave-In-Rock sometime this summer. Stay tuned for details.
4. Huntingburg Kiwanis Car Show: Dave informed members of the Huntingburg Kiwanis car show scheduled for April 17 in Huntingburg, IN. Flyers containing details will be sent to TSCC in the near future.
5. Window Decals: Dave proposed the club purchase window decals for member cars. The cost is approximately \$1/decals. Jeff Titzer will check on ordering details. Membership approved purchase of window decals with TSCC logo.
6. TSCC Car Flags: Jeff Burden will check on costs/order details for car flags with TSCC logo.
7. TSCC Club Apparel / Nametags: Bob Bean will provide vendor and ordering information to Colleen and Dave. Members wanting a nametag should contact Mike Hudson. Cost of nametag is \$7.00.
8. Indiana Pacers Outing: Charlie Bellamy recalled discussion concerning an outing to an Indiana Pacers basketball game. Bob Bean initially proposed the idea. Bob and Charlie will coordinate a date and details for this outing.
9. Saturday 'Garage Hop': Dave asked if members would be interested in doing a 'garage hop' on Saturdays.

### **GOVERNOR'S REPORT**

Governor Kevin Milton reported on the following Indiana Region events:

1. Spring Fling: April 25 in Indianapolis
2. Brown County 'Fun Day': Kevin informed members this is a picnic/cookout for Indiana Region members. Concern was raised that this event may conflict with our cruise-in date; however it was later discovered the Fun Day event is scheduled for Sunday, October 3. Phil Fuller and Kevin will coordinate details for TSCC members who want to attend.

### **VICE PRESIDENT'S REPORT**

VP Mike Hudson reported on the following:

1. National Corvette Museum Ambassador: This is a volunteer position to assist the NCM with fundraisers and other events. Mike is currently the NCM Ambassador. If anyone is interested in working with the NCM, please contact Mike for details.
2. Spring Car Show at Kenny Kent: Mike reported that Kenny Kent Chevrolet is having a Spring Car Show on April 24. This show would be similar to the show Kelly/Northside Chevrolet held in the past. Kent dealership rep informed Mike they will rope off an area of the parking lot for TSCC. There will be a band, DJ, food and 75 awards will be presented.
3. Mike informed members he purchased pictures of car shows held at Kelly/Northside Chevrolet that TSCC members attended. He will have copies made and framed and display the copies in our meeting room at Pizza Chef.
