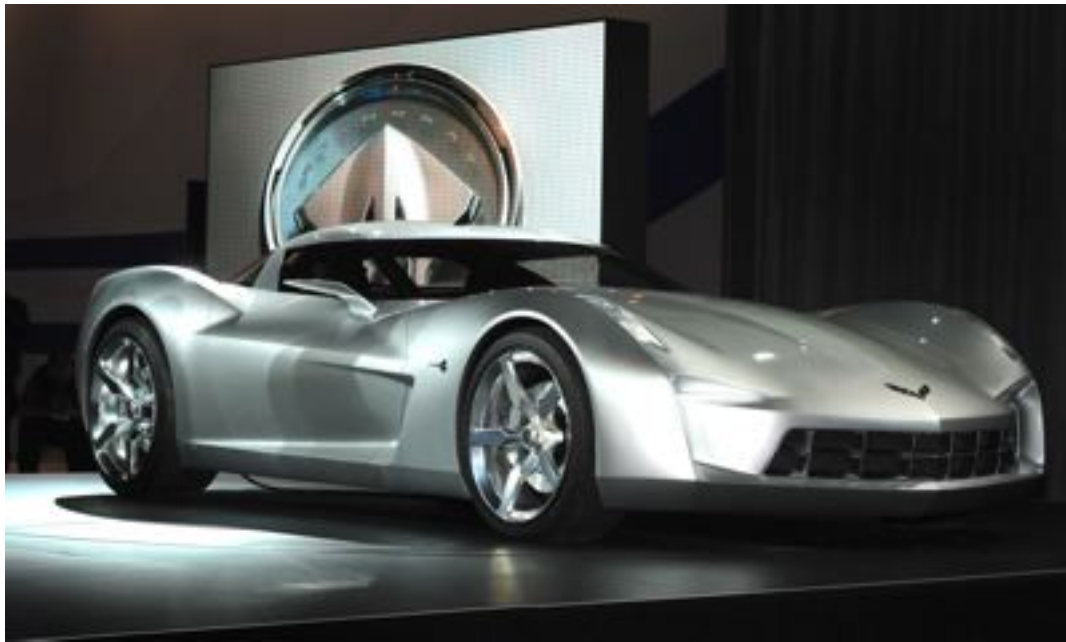

Motion was made and seconded to approve the January minutes as printed in the newsletter.

Treasurer Marylin Bean gave the financial report. It was approved as read.

President Bob Bean felt it necessary to address the FALSE rumors circulating about TSCC not rejoining NCCC in November. Bob explained that numerous club members have asked him what benefit NCCC is to TSCC. Because of these inquiries this topic was discussed at the January 20, 2009 Board of Directors Meeting. No action of any kind was taken by the Board. TSCC pays approximately \$2000 to \$2400 every year in NCCC dues. There is talk by NCCC of an increase in the yearly dues. The main benefit of being an NCCC member is the insurance for the club. In order for the insurance to be effective all club events need to be printed in the club's newsletter prior to the date of the event.

NCCC Governor Kevin Milton said NCCC is an asset for the club and money should not be an issue. Kevin suggested the club should restructure their finances to allow for the expense of the dues.

Dan Jaquess made the suggestion that the Blue Bars magazine published by NCCC should try to include more social events as well as the racing and autocross features.

Half pot of \$38 was won by Tim Seib.

Motion was made and seconded to adjourn the meeting.
