Members who are in good standing in the club at the time of a sponsored event are insured under the NCCC policy. Members include spouse and family while accepted by the insured club as participants at an event. The insurance basically covers every club activity. President Hurt encouraged members to notify himself or VP Hudson of any upcoming events so the event can be posted in the newsletter to be in accord with NCCC insurance guidelines. Governor Milton suggested adding this reminder to the next newsletter.
2. Club pictures can be forward to President Hurt or VP Hudson for posting on the website. They in turn will forward the photos to the web master.
